## **Tunable White Lighting Systems**

### **About the Presentation**

Description: The presentation will consist of a review of the basic technology behind controlling the spectrum of indoor lighting systems that have a positive effect on the users of commercial spaces by leveraging the concept of “tunable-lighting.”
